Wulf,2012-12-06 Current practice dictates the separation of the hardware and software development paths early in the design cycle These paths remain independent with very little interaction occurring between them until system integration In particular hardware is often specified without fully appreciating the computational requirements of the software Also software development does not influence hardware development and does not track changes made during the hardware design phase Thus the ability to explore hardware software tradeoffs is restricted such as the movement of functionality from the software domain to the hardware domain and vice versa or the modification of the hardware software interface As a result problems that are encountered during system integration may require modification of the software and or hardware resulting in potentially significant cost increases and schedule overruns To address the problems described above a cooperative design approach one that utilizes a unified view of hardware and software is described This approach is called hardware software codesign The Codesign of Embedded Systems develops several fundamental hardware software codesign concepts and a methodology that supports them A unified representation referred to as a decomposition graph is presented which can be used to describe hardware or software using
