These pressures can create a stressful environment for the construction project manager. This study was conducted to examine the perspectives of current construction project managers in the U.S. about how they execute their responsibilities in a stressful environment. Identifying these skills and strategies can provide educators and human resource managers with information that will help them better prepare and guide individuals pursuing the construction project manager career path. They also described the skills and strategies they have developed to persevere and be successful in their projects and their careers. The list of skills described was comprehensive and extensive but could be consolidated into two categories: soft skills or people skills and hard skills or technical skills. Strong emotional intelligence, team leadership, and
