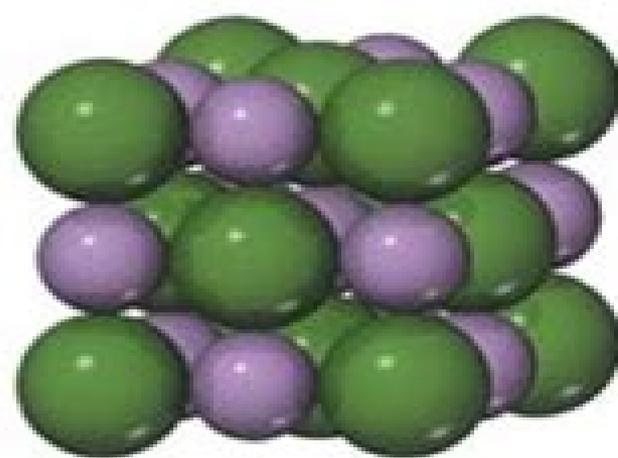


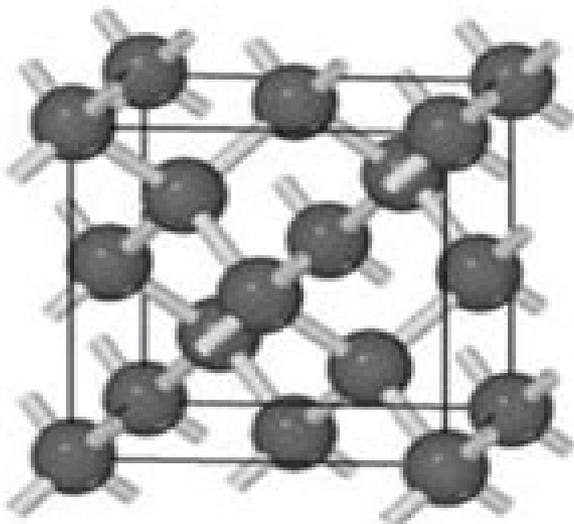

Extended networks of atoms held together by metallic bonding (Cu, Fe)




Ionic solids
