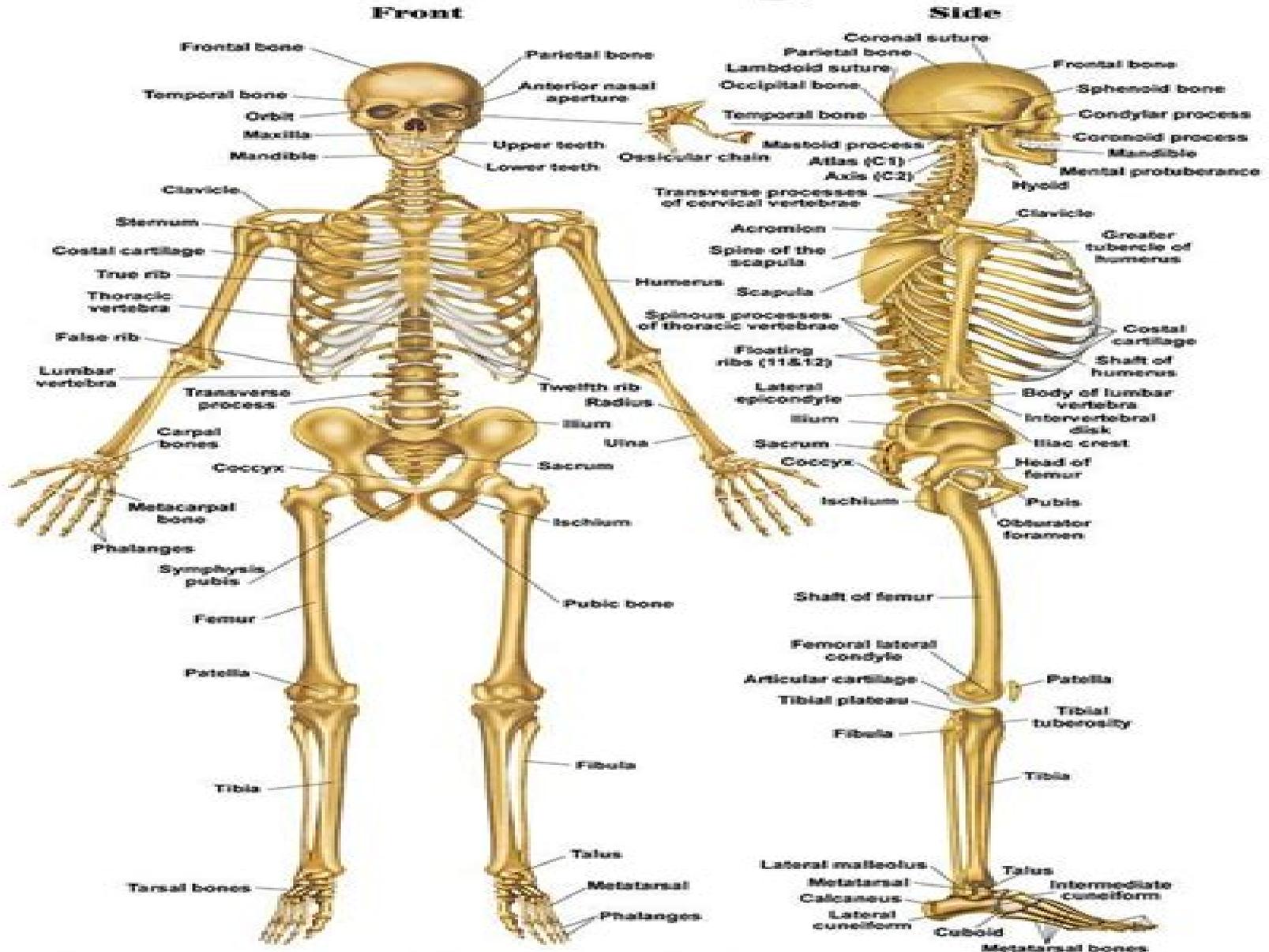


Skeletal System

The bone mass in the skeleton reaches maximum density around age 30.
