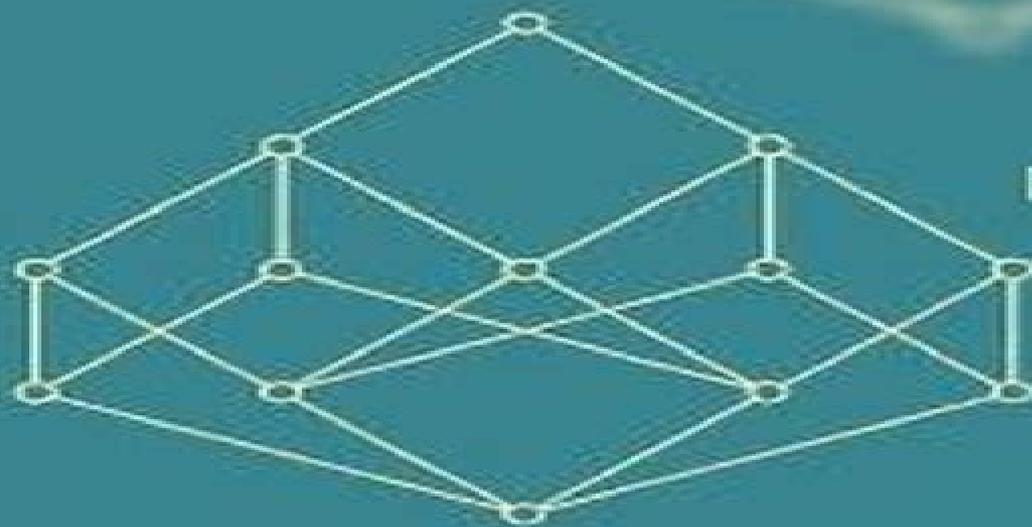

theory but then the subject lay relatively dormant until Garrett Birkhoff Oystein Ore and others picked it up in the 1930s Since then many noted mathematicians have contributed to the subject including Garrett Birkhoff Richard Dedekind Israel Gelfand George Gr tzer Aleksandr Kurosh Anatoly Malcev Oystein Ore Gian Carlo Rota Alfred Tarski and Johnny von Neumann
