


1. INTRODUCTION TO PSYCHOLOGY

1.1 What is Psychology?

- **Psychology:** the scientific study of the mind and body
- **Scientific Method:**
 - Form of empiricism
 - **Empirical Method:** based on observation, including experimentation



- **Scientific Theory:** the natural world that over time
 - Scientists test what is perceivable + measurable
 - ∴ psychological science is empirical, based on measurable data
 - Became own academic discipline in late 1800s
 - Before – considered under auspices of philosophy
 - Some areas take on aspects of natural sciences like biology
 - As behaviour is influenced by interactions with others – a social science
 - Psych students:
 - Hone critical thinking skills (active application of a set of skills to info for the understanding + evaluation of that info)
 - Scepticism
 - Recognizing internal biases
 - Logical thinking
 - Asking appropriate questions
 - Making observations
 - Develop better communication skills
