


A structure was built around the walls of the temple containing four levels. The lower chamber was 17 feet (5.2 m) wide and the middle chamber was 10 feet (3.0 m) wide and the upper chamber was 10.5 feet (3.2 m) wide (1 King 6:3-5, 16).

Two bronze vessels (chairs) covered with gold, supported the inner sanctuary. Each was 10 feet (3.0 m) long (1 King 6:21-22).

The inner sanctuary windows with windows (1 King 6:4).

The entrance was 20 feet (6.1 m) wide and 15 feet (4.6 m) deep (1 King 6:3, 2 Chron. 3:6).



The bronze basin (jar) on the north was called "Sea," and the one on the south was called "Laver" (1 King 7:23, 2 Chron. 3:15).

The bronze altar for burnt offerings was 15 feet (4.6 m) high and 20 feet (6.1 m) long and was of 2 Chron. 4:1).

Two bronze vessels, holding olive oil, covered with gold, supported the lamp (1 King 6:23-25).

The inner sanctuary for the holy food was a 20 feet (6.1 m) cube (1 King 6:17-20, 2 Chron. 3:8-10), built inside the temple after it was built. The inner sanctuary was on either side of the 40 feet (12.2 m) long and 15 feet (4.6 m) wide (1 King 6:17-20, 2 Chron. 3:8-10). ### SOLOMON'S TEMPLE

God had begun to build "the house of the Lord" in Jerusalem about 480 or 490 B.C. (1 King 6:1, 2 Chron. 3:1) and completed it seven years later in 475 or 474 B.C. (1 King 6:38). The temple itself, not including the surrounding structures on the east side, was 60 feet (18.3 m) long, 30 feet (9.1 m) wide, and 30 feet (9.1 m) high. It was built in the middle of a great wall surrounding the city.
