*Care of Bees in Frame Hives* Joe Bleasdale, 2019-07-05 Natural Beekeeping with Frame Hives There is a growing acceptance among many beekeepers of the principles of minimum intervention and avoidance of chemicals in the hive. Beekeepers with standard frame hives will find their colonies benefit when they care for their bees as described in this book. This will result in reduced stress, happier bees, and sustainably obtained honey. The Natural Beekeeping movement has gained many followers, people concerned with the plight of bees and their environment using Top Bar hives including the Warr and skeps. With the increased scope and flexibility offered by frame hives, they can gain a better understanding of the behaviour of their bees and still adhere to the principles of Natural Beekeeping. I have included a chapter that shows how my methods differ from those conventional practices taught by national beekeeping associations, which I maintain are not beneficial. This summarises my beekeeping practices and rationale:

- 1 I do not apply chemicals or medicate my hives. Bees know how to use what nature provides: minerals from the soil and water, sources of propolis from plants, complex vitamins and essential oils from flowers, nectar, and pollen.
- 2 I do not kill queen cells in order to prevent swarming. This may delay a prime swarm, but secondary swarms will emerge and deplete the hive.
- 3 I do not clip the queen's wing to prevent her flying with the swarm. I believe it is a cruel practice and damages the queen and weakens the colony.
- 4 I do not mark the queen. Marking the queen is a difficult operation and you may damage her, whether you use paint or a sticky label. What is the point in marking the queen? You can tell if the hive has a laying queen if there is brood with young larvae or eggs in the middle brood frames. You do not even need to open the hive if the bees are bringing in pollen.
- 5 I do not cull drones in order to remove drone cells whose larvae may be parasitised by varroa. It prevents the natural reproduction of those colonies that are inherently resistant to varroa. A large population of drones from many hives provides a wide variety of genes and vigour to the offspring of a well-mated queen.
- 6 I do not feed my established hives. Many conventional beekeepers feed sugar syrup as a matter of course before winter to make up for the honey they have removed. The bees' own honey is the best food they can get for surviving winter, and it helps the colony to build up its strength in the spring. Instead of feeding the hive, I leave enough honey for it to overwinter. This pays dividends in a stronger colony for the following year and therefore a greater yield of honey.
- 7 I do not requeen a hive by removing the old queen. Besides being cruel and ungrateful, you are losing valuable genetic material that in nature would survive in her swarm or a superseding daughter.
- 8 I no longer buy wax foundation, which is made from beeswax supplied by other beekeepers, many of whom follow the advice of government bodies and national and beekeeping associations and put various chemicals and medicines in their hives. Beeswax is very absorbent of these poisons, and I don't want them in my hives.
- 9 I do not obtain bees from outside my local area. Importing bees from distant localities or foreign countries is bad; it

puts stress on the bees and the bees are not acclimated to their new locality. Local bees will have adapted genetically to their environment and climate. All my colonies have descended from swarms, most of which entered my empty hives and bait hives with no effort on my part. Swarming bees are healthy bees.
