SADC Gender Protocol 2017 Barometer Morna, Colleen Lowe, Makamure, Lucia, 2017-10-04 The SADC Protocol on Gender and Development is the only sub regional instrument in the world that brings together global and continental commitments to gender equality in one instrument used to enhance accountability The Southern African Gender Protocol Alliance is a network of country and regional NGOs that campaigned for the Protocol its updating implementation and tracking Originally aligned to the Millennium Development Goals that expired in 2015 SADC Gender Ministers updated the Protocol and aligned it to the Sustainable development Goals SDGs Beijing Plus Twenty and the Africa Agenda 2063 in 2016 In July 2017 the Ministers adopted a Monitoring Evaluation and Reporting Framework MERF that will be the basis of future reporting Now in its ninth edition the 2017 Barometer is the first assessment of the Post 2015 SADC Gender Protocol Moving with the times the Alliance has expanded the two key main yardsticks in the Barometer the SADC Gender and Development Index SGDI and the Citizen Score Card CSC The Barometer incorporates many MERF and SDG indicators as well as its own unique measures of voice choice and control The Barometer also introduces the Gender Responsive Assessment of Constitutions and Laws conducted by Alliance experts and networks around the region A wealth of data insights and analysis awaits all readers of the Barometer that will also be made available online and in multi media formats The SADC we want is one in which citizens engage step it up for gender equality and make sure we achieve Planet 50 50 by 2030

Understanding Gender in Maldives Jana El-Horr, Rohini Prabha Pande, 2016-06-07 Within the past decade the Maldives moved from poverty to middle income status introduced democracy and was hailed as a Millennium Development Goal Plus country Women face little discrimination in basic aspects of life such as primary education health and survival unlike in much of South Asia This economic and social progress has yet to be fully inclusive however and gender inequality endures despite constitutional guarantees to the contrary This is at least partly due to a shift in the nature of Islamic practice in the Maldives towards more rigidly patriarchal interpretations Women s labor force participation is high but limited to lower echelons of the economy Women are slightly more likely than men to be unemployed Despite gender equal primary schooling girls access to tertiary and professional education is hampered by beliefs about girls and women s mobility and primacy of household roles over others Within the home women face challenges that men do not such as high risks of domestic violence and little control over household assets Finally women have limited presence in politics and governance Men struggle with different gendered situations Unemployment is high among young men who also increasingly are alienated from society and family This alienation combined with a lack of strong alternative social structures to replace the breakdown of traditional family structures that has accompanied Maldives development trajectory appear to be propelling young men towards greater social conservatism participation in gangs drug use and violence Nonetheless women are more disadvantaged in more realms of life than are men Moreover public support for gender equality and women s rights appears to be declining These developments

are worrying for the future of gender equality in the Maldives as well as for a more inclusive development model that would offer opportunities to both men and women

Neupane, Sumanta, Jangid, Manita, Scott, Samuel, Nguyen, Phuong Hong, Kim, Sunny S., Murira, Zivai, Torlesse, Harriet, Menon, Purnima, 2021-07-15 The World Health Organization WHO and other global nutrition and health agencies recommend nutrition actions across the life course to address malnutrition in all its forms In this report we examined how Maldives nutrition policies and programs addressed recommended nutrition actions determinants and outcomes We reviewed population based surveys and assess the availability of data on nutrition actions nutrition outcomes and the determinants of these outcomes Our policy review identified a total of 53 recommended evidence based nutrition actions of these 49 nutrition actions were applicable in Maldives and 31 were addressed in the country s nutrition policies and programs The Maldives nutrition plan the Integrated National Nutrition Strategic Plan or INNSP recognized and addressed all key determinants of nutrition except women s status appropriate age of marriage childbirth and infectious diseases the country s nutrition plan aimed to track progress on all nutrition outcome indicators Our data review found that of 31 actions addressed by policies and programs population based surveys contained data on only 22 actions Neither of the population based surveys contained data on a range of actions including advice on consuming iron and folic acid IFA during pregnancy support for early initiation of breastfeeding and immediate skin to skin contact optimal feeding of low birth weight infants counseling of mothers of low birth weight infants on kangaroo mother care KMC during delivery and postpartum period counseling on infant and young child feeding IYCF growth monitoring and counseling after growth monitoring during early childhood The population based surveys contained data on most of the indicators for immediate and underlying determinants indicators that were not available included maternal dietary diversity during pregnancy household food insecurity and coverage under social protection schemes With the exception of anemia among non pregnant women data on all nutrition outcomes was available in population based surveys In conclusion Maldives should consider updating its national policies and programs to address existing gaps in recommended nutrition actions in addition future population based surveys may also need to be revised to fill identified data gaps around nutrition actions and determinants

Central Statistical Office,2016 *Are data available for tracking progress on nutrition policies, programs, and outcomes in Bhutan?* Jangid, Manita,Neupane, Sumanta,Scott, Samuel,Nguyen, Phuong Hong,Kim, Sunny S.,Murira, Zivai,Torlesse, Harriet,Menon, Purnima,2021-07-15 The World Health Organization WHO and other global nutrition and health agencies recommend nutrition actions throughout the life course in order to address malnutrition in all its forms In this report we examined how Bhutan s nutrition policies and programs addressed recommended nutrition actions determinants and outcomes We reviewed population based surveys to assess the availability of data on nutrition actions nutrition outcomes and the determinants of these outcomes we also assessed the data availability in administrative data systems for selected nutrition actions and outcomes Our policy review identified a total of 53 recommended nutrition actions of which 48 were applicable in Bhutan of those Bhutan s nutrition policies addressed 46 and programs addressed 41 Nutrition actions that were not included in current policies and programs were iron and folic acid IFA supplementation and deworming during preconception food supplementation for malnourished lactating women and IFA supplementation during early childhood Policies addressed four actions for which there were no programs to implement it daily IFA supplementation and deworming during preconception advice about weight gain after weighing during pregnancy outpatient management of severe acute malnutrition SAM and management of moderate acute malnutrition MAM during early childhood National strategies and plans recognized and aimed to address all key determinants of nutrition except coverage under social protection schemes National strategies and plans showed an intention to track progress of all other nutrition outcome indicators except underweight among non pregnant women 15 to 49 years overweight among school children and adolescents five to 19 years and hypertension among adults Of 41 actions that Bhutan s policies and programs addressed our data review found that population based surveys contained data on only 17 actions similarly out of 15 actions we reviewed in the administrative data systems data was available on seven actions Data was not available from population based surveys on a number of indicators including those related to IFA supplementation deworming and food

supplementation during adolescence calcium supplementation deworming weight monitoring and counseling during pregnancy newborn care during delivery and the postnatal period and infant and young child feeding IYCF growth monitoring immunization identification and management of SAM and MAM during early childhood Population based surveys contained data on 18 of 20 indicators on immediate and underlying determinants Data on dietary diversity among pregnant women and on coverage of households under social protection schemes were not available in either the administrative data systems or the population based surveys The population based surveys contained data on all nutrition outcomes except overweight among adolescents In conclusion Bhutan s policy landscape for nutrition is robust The gaps in availability of data for tracking progress on nutrition are large however and much greater than are the gap in policies and programs for addressing recommended actions Future population based surveys and modifications of other data systems should aim to fill the identified data gaps for nutrition action and outcome indicators
