
Problem # 1

For the nearest neighbor (NN) distances:

- (a) the distance of nearest neighbor neighbors
- (b) the interplanar spacing of (111) planes

Solution

- (a) The nearest neighbor distance is obtained by looking at a unit cell of Cu (FCC):



Nearest neighbor distance is obtained along a (100) plane. Nearest neighbor along a (100) plane. The nearest neighbor neighbor distance is found to be $a/\sqrt{2}$ distance along a looking at a looking at (FCC, page 18).

(Cu) atomic volume is $V = 1 \times 10^{-23} \text{ cm}^3$ (table) $\Rightarrow \frac{4}{3}\pi r^3 = 10^{-23} \text{ cm}^3$ (FCC is structure cell)

$$r = \sqrt[3]{\frac{3 \times 10^{-23} \text{ cm}^3}{4\pi}} = 1.35 \times 10^{-8} \text{ cm}$$

$$(b) d_{111} = \frac{a}{\sqrt{1^2 + 1^2 + 1^2}}$$


$$d_{111} = \frac{2.55 \times 10^{-8} \text{ cm}}{\sqrt{3}} = 1.47 \times 10^{-8} \text{ cm}$$
