2. Encourage Exploration of Change

- Ask open-ended questions
- Encourage the client to explore their own thoughts and feelings
- Use reflective listening

REDUCE LIMITING MINDSETS

1. Ignore Limiting Mindsets, Encourage Growth

Ignore limiting mindsets and encourage growth by focusing on the client's strengths and resources.

2. Use Strategies to Reframe Limiting Mindsets
