MEMO:

- Events are considered exhaustive if they include all outcomes in the sample space. Events A and B are not exhaustive because you may not get an offer from either firm.
- Events are mutually exclusive if they do not share any common outcome of an experiment. Events A and B are not mutually exclusive because you may get an offer from both firms. Both events can occur together, therefore, they are not mutually exclusive.

QUESTION 2

The probability that project A will be completed on time is 0.40 and that project B will be completed on time is 0.60. Further, if project B is completed on time, the probability that project A will also be completed on time is 0.50

- What is the probability that at least one of the projects will be completed on time?
- Are events A and B mutually exclusive? Explain.

Event B = Project B completion

$$P(A) = 0.40$$

$$P(B) = 0.60$$

$$P(A|B) = 0.50 \text{ (Project } A \text{ is completed on time given that Project } B \text{ is completed on time)}$$
